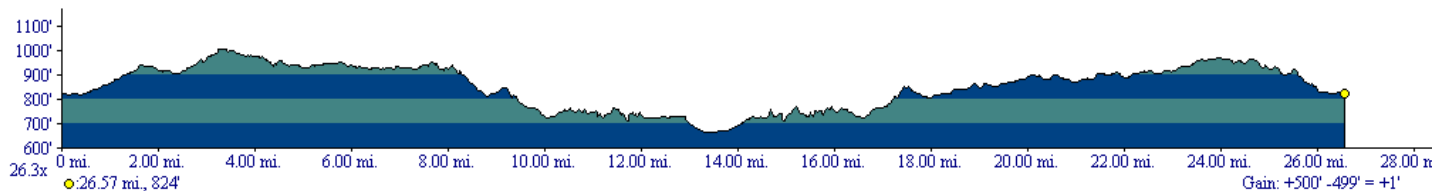


The Raincross Ride

The Raincross Ride has been a tradition in Riverside for a few years running every Saturday morning. The ride takes you through the Historic Victoria District, out to Home Gardens (Corona East) and back. Ride length is about 26 miles and the climbing is minimal. The ride starts and finishes in a parking lot on Central just north of the library.

The group ride starts at 8am on Saturday. If you opt for the group ride, be prepared to keep an average speed of over 25mph and you must be able to hit speeds well over 30 mph. Many riders use this for race training. If you plan to do this on your own, enjoy the scenery and the few fruit groves still in Riverside.



1. From the parking make a right onto Central.
2. Make a left onto Magnolia which is the first signal.
3. Make a left on Brockton (signal).
4. Continue on Brockton under the freeway and it changes to Mary.
5. Make a right turn onto Victoria (stop sign).
6. A couple blocks down on Victoria, make a left onto Madison (stop sign).
7. Make a right at end of Madison onto Dufferin.
8. Make a right at end of Dufferin onto Jefferson (stop sign) and an immediate left back onto Dufferin.
9. Stay on Dufferin through signal at Van Buren and continue till the end.
10. Make a right turn onto La Sierra (stop sign). Watch for traffic.
11. Make a left at Victoria, the first signal.
12. At the top of the hill make a right turn onto Fillmore.
13. At the bottom of Fillmore make a left onto Indiana.
14. Take Indiana for a while to Grant. Make a right turn.
15. Turn right at the bottom of Grant onto Magnolia. (stop sign)
16. The next big signal is McKinley, turn right.
17. At the top of the hill, make a left onto Indiana.
18. Take Indiana for a while and make a right turn onto Fillmore. (stop sign)
19. Make a left at the top of Fillmore onto Victoria. (stop sign)
20. Ride Victoria for a while, cross Arlington and make a left on Central (signal).
21. Take Central under the freeway (watch for traffic) and pull into the parking lot a couple blocks up on the right.
